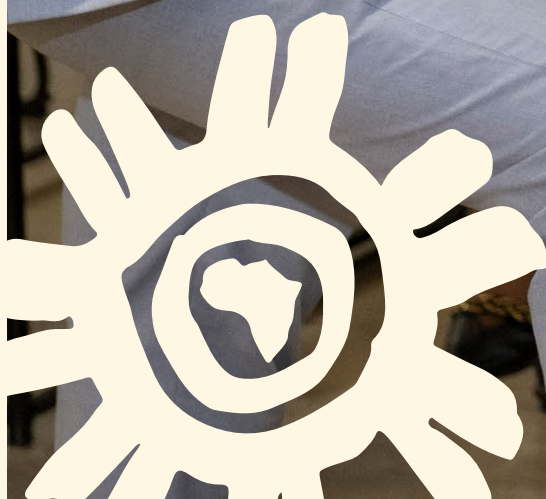

ASBN connected a Scottish based energy servicing company with one of our member companies after being approached by the Aberdeen firm to help them find a local partner who works across the African continent. ASBN put them in touch with a shortlist of companies. The servicing firm chose ASBN member Gulf Marine Contractors to assist them with compliance requirements, staffing, suppliers and logistics for oil rigs in South Africa. 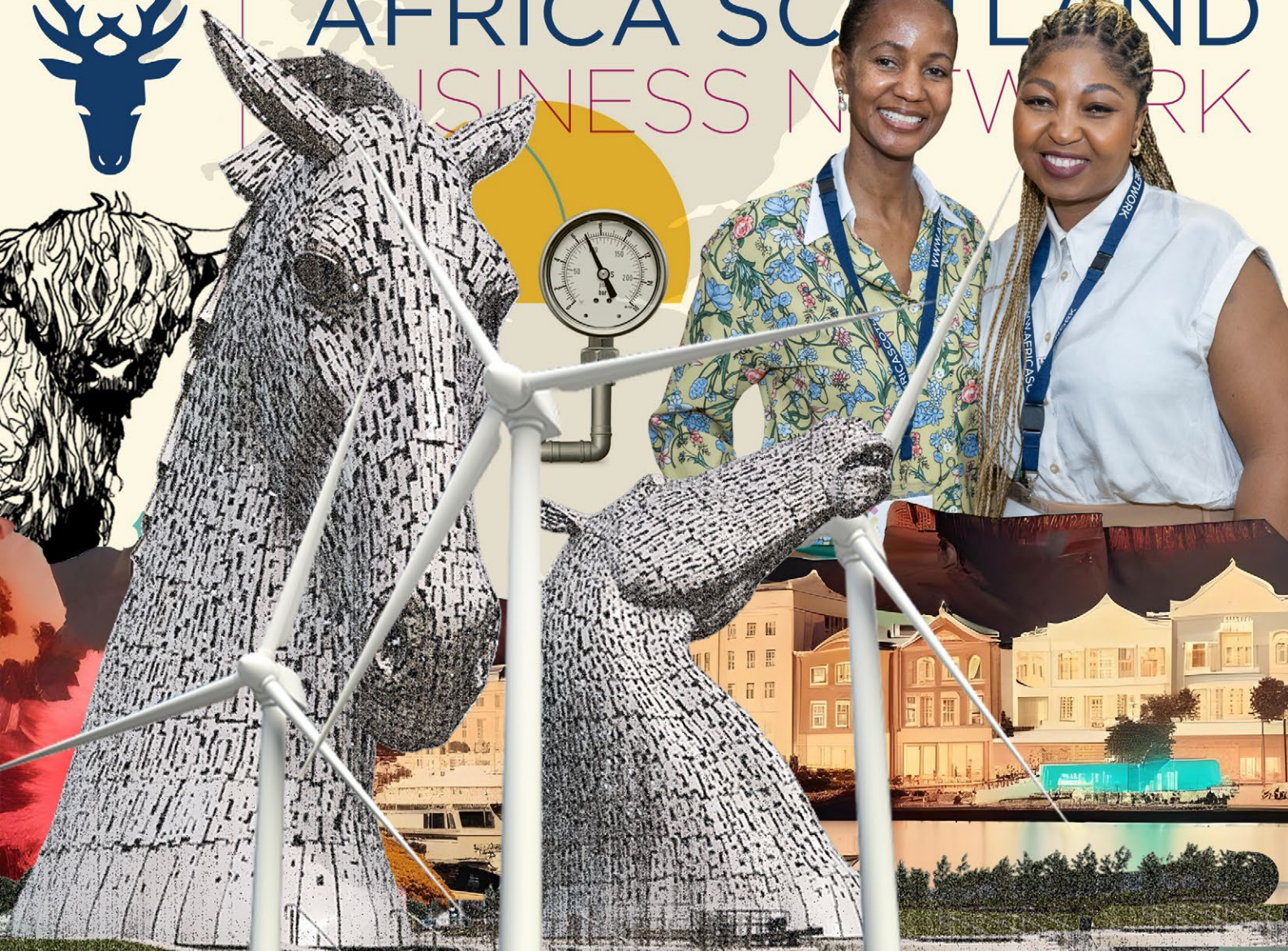

ASBN has grown into a respected international business network, representing over 110 member companies with head offices in 15 countries.

PARTNERSHIPS

To date, ASBN has facilitated 21 partnerships across multiple sectors industries and countries.

EVENT MILESTONES

We marked our 45th event in Glasgow in June 2024. Our events have been hosted at top venues, including the Scottish Parliament, Barclays Campus in Glasgow, Bowmans Law Firm in Cape Town, British High Commissioner's Residency in Cape Town, Tourvest Holdings HQ in Johannesburg, University of Stirling campus in Stirling, and Citation in Glasgow.

JOB CREATION

We have created six jobs in South Africa. Our team will continue to grow as our network does!

STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIPS

ASBN has six strategic, international partners.

TRADE DELEGATIONS

ASBN leads trade delegations into Africa in conjunction with large conferences and platforms, as well as managing private company delegations for members and clients. In 2024, ASBN assisted OPITO with a private delegation for their global clients into South Africa.

GOVERNMENT COMMISSIONS

We were commissioned by the Scottish Government to research and produce the first Africa Scotland Economic Impact Report, aiming to transform current international trading policies on Africa.

ENERGY TECHNOLOGY EVENT SERIES

Commissioned by Scottish Development, we designed and executed a five-part Energy Technology Event Series to promote Scottish energy SMMEs in African markets, successfully welcoming 320 participants to this virtual event series.

EXHIBITION LEADERSHIP

ASBN produced the first-ever Scottish Development International exhibition show in Africa at the Windaba Conference in 2021.
